

Narthex Use Guidelines

F. Narthex

1. The Narthex is a place for preparation for worship. Please respect this and keep conversations to a low volume.
2. AUMC groups wishing to use the Narthex area for missional/educational sign-ups shall abide by the following guidelines:
 - A. The display for any single group shall not be any larger than the space occupied by an easel.
 - B. No more than two groups may have displays in the Narthex at any one time. This usage will be regulated by making Narthex reservations through the church office. *(see attached form)*
 - C. Displays may not block access to restrooms, water fountains, exit doors or sanctuary doors.
 - D. Displays may not be stored in the closet in the Narthex. Those items stored are subject to disposal. Easels are stored in the closet on the right as you enter the Narthex.
 - E. Displays are limited to two weeks.
 - F. AUMC groups wishing to fundraise in support of missional and educational opportunities may do so in the lobby of the educational building, or on the grounds outside of the sanctuary. If tables or displays are set up in front of the sanctuary doors, they should be 12 feet away from the sidewalk.
